### NOTES

- There were 551 complaints in 2011. Most traffic tickets are not included as complaints.
- The three biggest areas of complaint seem to be traffic issues (parking, moving traffic, tree issues), nuisance issues (unsightly properties) and animal issues (animals at large, barking dogs).

High Priority Issues for 2012

- Nuisance properties, especially graffiti, maintenance of alleys and uncut grass.
- Overgrown and unmaintained trees in the back alleys.
- Dogs/cats at large and unlicensed dogs/cats.
- Moving traffic in school zones, playground zones, Main St and Hwy 14.
- OHV's in the Hwy. 14 ditches and in the Town's parks and green spaces.
- Sidewalk snow removal in high pedestrian traffic and high risk areas (Main St /downtown, Senior's Lodge, school zones).
