TOWN OF WAINWRIGHT BYLAW 2022 – 05

A Bylaw of the Town of Wainwright in the Province of Alberta to authorize the provision of TELUS' Next Generation 9-1-1 Service for the residents of the Town of Wainwright.

WHEREAS pursuant to the provisions of the Municipal Government Act, Revised Statutes of Alberta 2000, Chapter M-26, Council may pass a bylaw for municipal purposes respecting the safety, health and welfare of people and the protection of people and property;

AND WHEREAS Council of the Town of Wainwright wishes to provide its citizen with access to Next Generation 9-1-1 Emergency Services;

NOW THEREFORE, pursuant to section 7 of the Municipal Government Act, Revised Statues of Alberta 2000, Chapter M-26, the Council of the Town of Wainwright, in the Province of Alberta, duly assembled, hereby enacts as follows:

- 1. The Town of Wainwright enter into an agreement with TELUS Communications Inc. for the provision of Next Generation 9-1-1 Emergency Services.
- 2. The East Central 911 Call Answer Society shall be the primary Public Safety Answering Point (PSAP) to which 9-1-1 calls, sessions and events are routed directly as the first point of contact.
- 3. This Bylaw shall come into full force and effect upon passing of the third reading.
- 4. This Bylaw shall repeal Bylaw 2005-02.

READ a first time in Council this 16th day of August, 2022.

READ a second time in Council this 15th day of August, 2022.

READ a third time in Council and passed this 16th day of August, 2022.
