REGULATIONS FOR PLACING ELECTION SIGNAGE ON TOWN BOULEVARDS

- Signs placed in street boulevards shall have the adjacent land owner's or occupant's permission.
- Signs may be placed on boulevards adjacent to Town lands in accordance with these regulations except that no signs will be allowed on the PMM or Cplex grounds or in front of the Town Hall, Library, or RCMP building.
- Signs are to have their own means of support. They are not permitted to be affixed to any power poles, public fences or trees, transformer boxes, or any other street furniture.
- Signs shall be a maximum of 8ft² (0.74m²) in area.
- Signs shall be placed where they do not cause any obstruction to vehicle or pedestrian traffic and shall not block intersection sight lines. Signs shall not be placed within 16.4ft (5m) of an intersection.
- All signs shall be maintained in good condition and shall not become a nuisance.
- All signs shall be removed within 24 hours of the conclusion of the election.
