## TOWN OF WAINWRIGHT BYLAW 2025 – 03

A Bylaw of the Town of Wainwright in the Province of Alberta to establish a temporary speed limit reduction in a construction zone within the Town of Wainwright.

WHEREAS the Council of the Town of Wainwright deems it necessary to establish provisions for temporary speed limit reductions in areas along highways and adjacent to highways undergoing construction to ensure the safety of workers, motorists, and pedestrians;

AND WHEREAS the Traffic Safety Act, R.S.A. 2000, Chapter T-6 and amendments thereto, provides that a municipality may make bylaws to regulate, manage and control vehicle traffic on highways within the municipality;

AND WHEREAS provisions of the Municipal Government Act, Revised Statutes of Alberta 2000, Chapter M-26 and amendments thereto, gives a municipality certain powers with respect to highways within the municipality;

NOW THEREFORE the Town of Wainwright desires to establish the following highways as Construction Zones and reduce vehicle speed along the highways from 50 kilometers per hour to 30 kilometers per hour:

- 27<sup>th</sup> Street (from 6<sup>th</sup> Avenue to 8<sup>th</sup> Avenue)
  - Including the intersection at 27<sup>th</sup> Street and 8<sup>th</sup> Avenue
  - Including the intersection at 27<sup>th</sup> Street and 6<sup>th</sup> Avenue
- 8<sup>th</sup> Avenue (from 25<sup>th</sup> Street to 27<sup>th</sup> Street)
  - Including the intersection at 27<sup>th</sup> Street and 8<sup>th</sup> Avenue
  - Including the intersection at 25<sup>th</sup> Street and 8<sup>th</sup> Avenue
- 1. All streets at the above-mentioned highways will have traffic control devices at the appropriate locations displaying "Construction Zone" and speed limits. See Attachment A.
- 2. The speed limit will be set at 30 kilometers per hour, enforced 24 hours a day, 7 days a week.
- 3. The temporary speed limit shall remain in effect for eighteen (18) months, until construction is completed, or until deemed unnecessary by Town Council.
- 4. Upon removal of signage, the speed limit shall revert to the previously established speed limit for the highway.
- 5. This Bylaw shall come into full force and effect upon passing of the third reading.

READ a first time in Council this 1st day of April, 2025.

READ a second time in Council this 1st day of April, 2025.

READ a third and final time in Council this 1st day of April, 2025.
