

## TOWN OF WAINWRIGHT OFF-HIGHWAY VEHICLE BYLAW 2010-01

## **SUMMARY OF REGULATIONS**

Off-highway vehicle (OHV) is defined as any motorized vehicle designed for cross country travel and includes snowmobiles, quads, motorcycles and any similar type of vehicle regardless of whether or not it is registered for on-road use.

- 1. OHVs must be properly registered and insured to operate in Town.
- 2. The operation of OHVs in Town is restricted to proceeding from the operator's residence to out of Town and back using the most direct route and using lanes as much as possible.
- 3. The speed of operation of any OHV in Town is limited to 20 kph.
- 4. OHVs are not to be operated on any Town parkland, the golf course, or the Highway 14 and 41 ditches.
- 5. OHVs are not to be operated in Town between the hours of 10:00 pm and 7:00 am.
- 6. Drivers and riders of OHVs are required to wear appropriate helmets.
- 7. Peace Officers are authorized to impound OHVs being operated in a dangerous manner or by repeat offenders.
