
2024 ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT COMMUNITY SURVEY


- We have seen a pile of growth over the years, though what I notice is diminishing small businesses and lots of empty storefronts in the older part of town, and more and more chains moving in




Q3 What percentage of your monthly purchases are from local businesses?




Q5 What percentage of your monthly purchases are you travelling out-of-town for?






Q8 Do you shop ONLINE?


Q9 What percentage of your monthly purchases are done online (from stores out-of-town)?






