





POLICY STATEMENT:

The purpose of this policy is to provide a fee structure and procedures for Tory Heights and PMP ball diamonds.

PROCEDURES:

That effective February 18, 2026 the fees be as follows:

All rates are subject to GST unless otherwise indicated.

Youth	\$99.09 per team per season
Adult Slo-Pitch/Fastball	\$330.73 per team per season
Youth Single Use Rental	\$30.00
Adult Single Use Rental	\$40.45
Youth 1-Day Tournament	\$254.59
Youth Weekend Tournament	\$370.76
Adult 1-Day Tournament	\$370.76
Adult Weekend Tournament	\$485.10
Extended Season/Provincial Team/Fall Ball	\$70.00 per team

1. Season rates guarantee a minimum of one night per week (weather permitting).
2. Teams are responsible for lining of diamonds and placement of bases.
3. For tournaments, the Town will drag the diamonds prior to the start of the tournament only.
4. Tournament fees are per complex or 4 diamonds. Tory Heights and PMP complexes have 4 diamonds per complex.
5. Tournaments include an additional 1 – 2 porta potties at the Town's cost, depending on the size of the tournament. If more than that are needed, it will be at the tournament host's cost.
6. Extended Season means the following:

Minor ball – it is any team entering provincial playdowns, playing past the regular minor ball league, playing into July and August.

Adult rentals – it is any team deciding to play longer than the original agreed upon schedule. If the schedule is deemed to be longer than it typically or historically has been, the fee will be implemented.

If a season is prolonged due to weather, that would not be considered an extended season and therefore would not be charged the extra fee.

The extended season fee is ultimately administered by and at the discretion of the Director of Parks and Recreation.

REVIEW CYCLE:

This policy will be reviewed every two (2) years.
