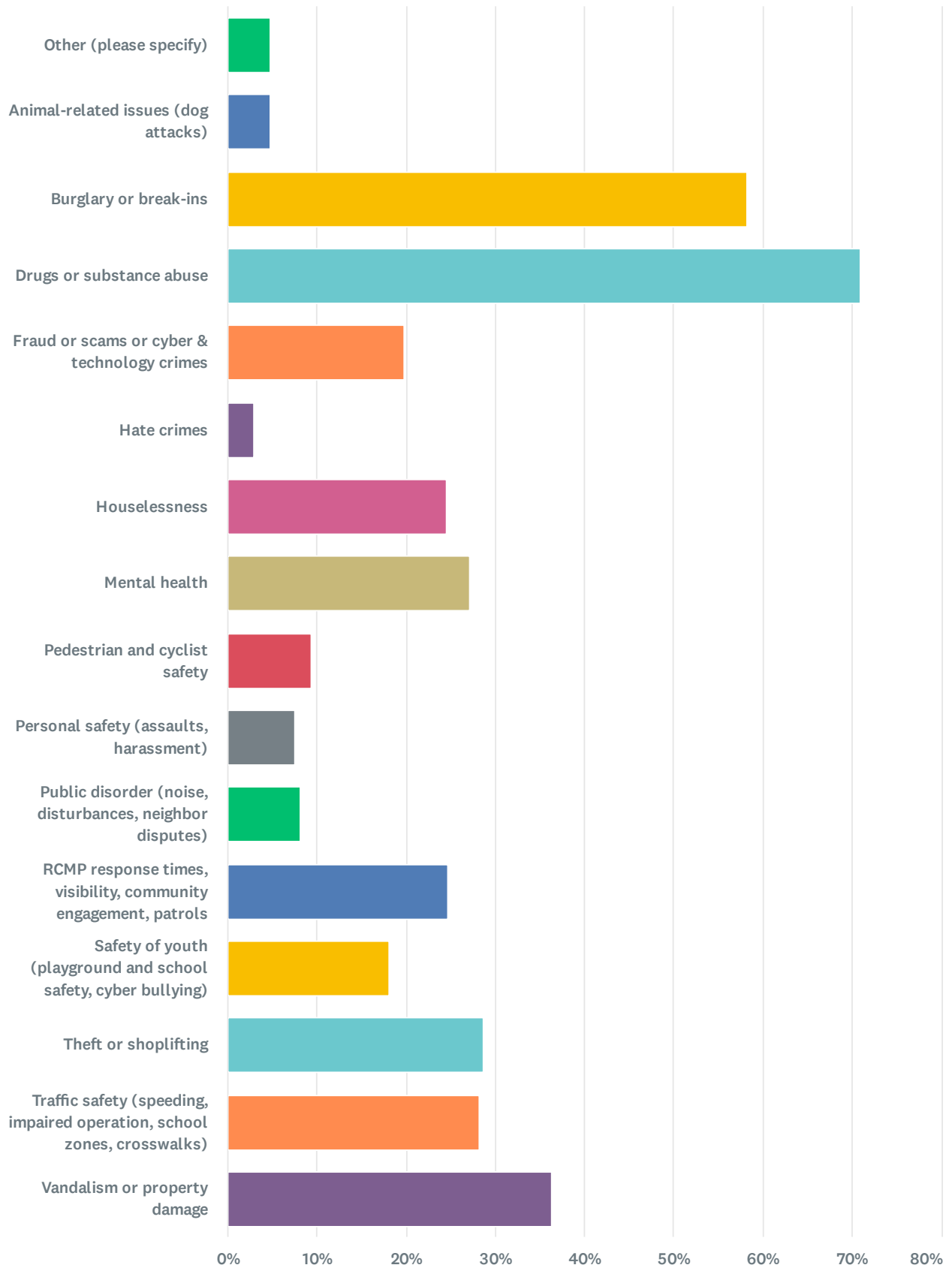

- **Safety of Vulnerable Individuals:** 7 comments

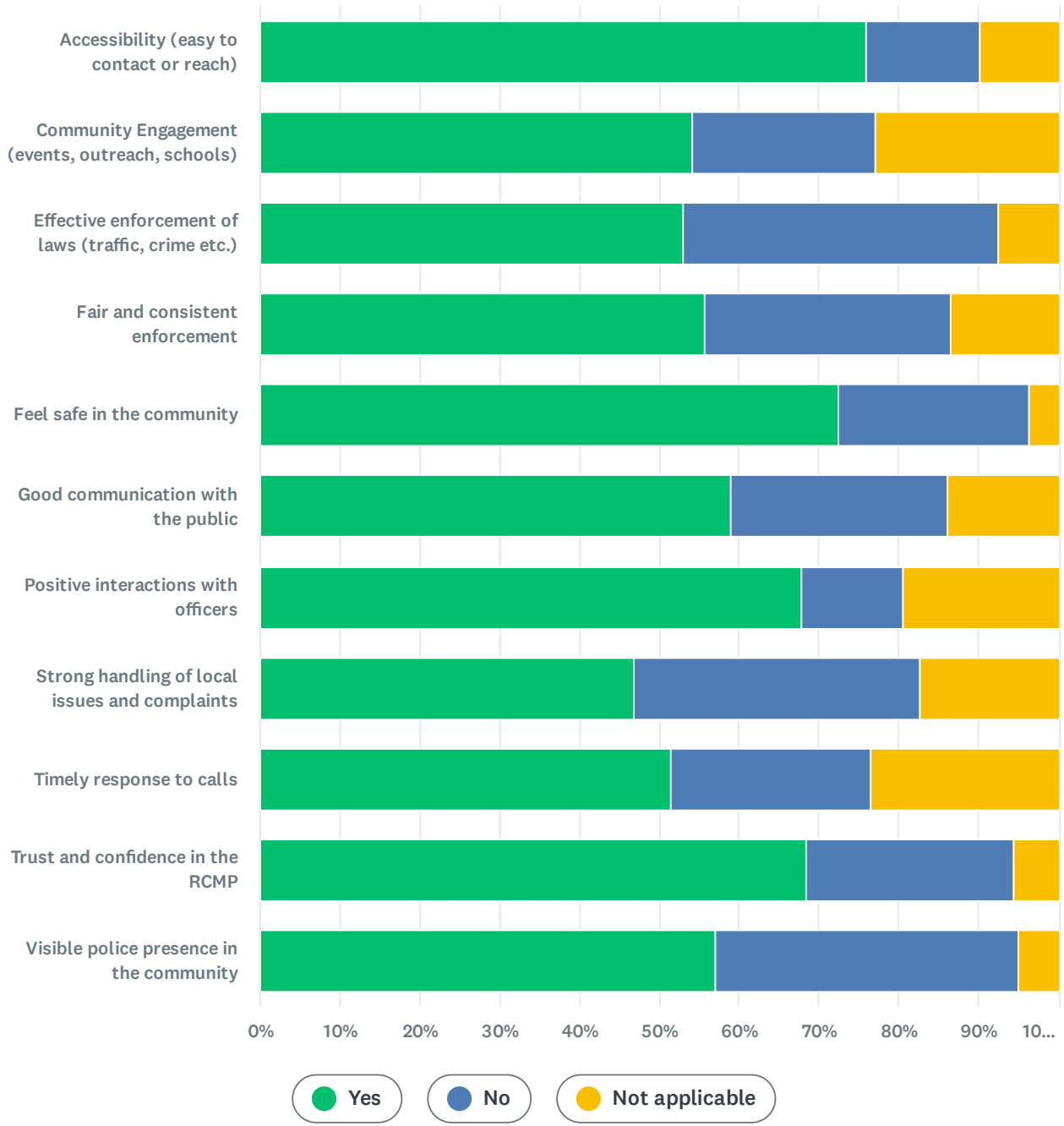

How safe do you feel in the Town of Wainwright?



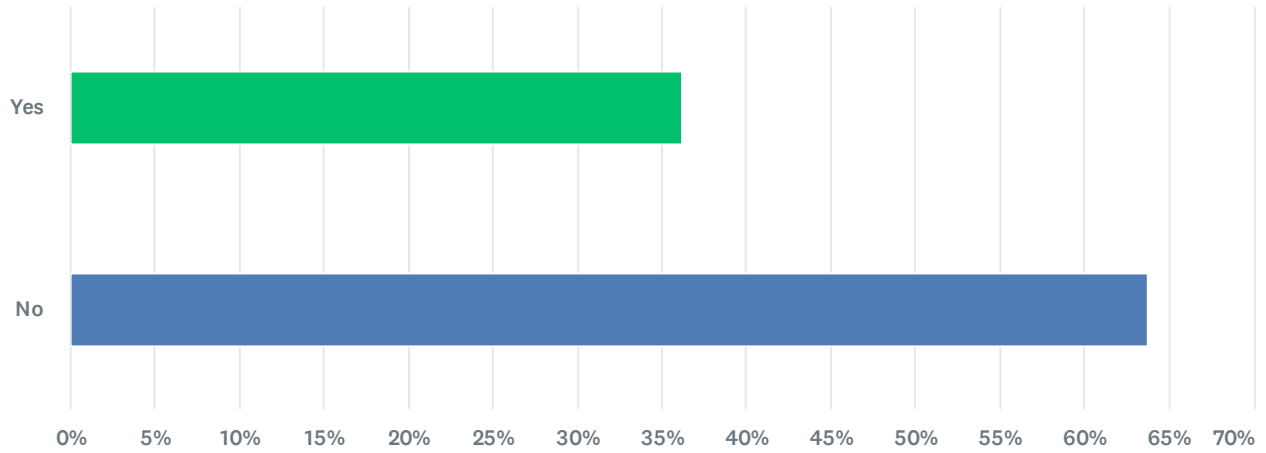

Are you satisfied with the RCMP services listed below?



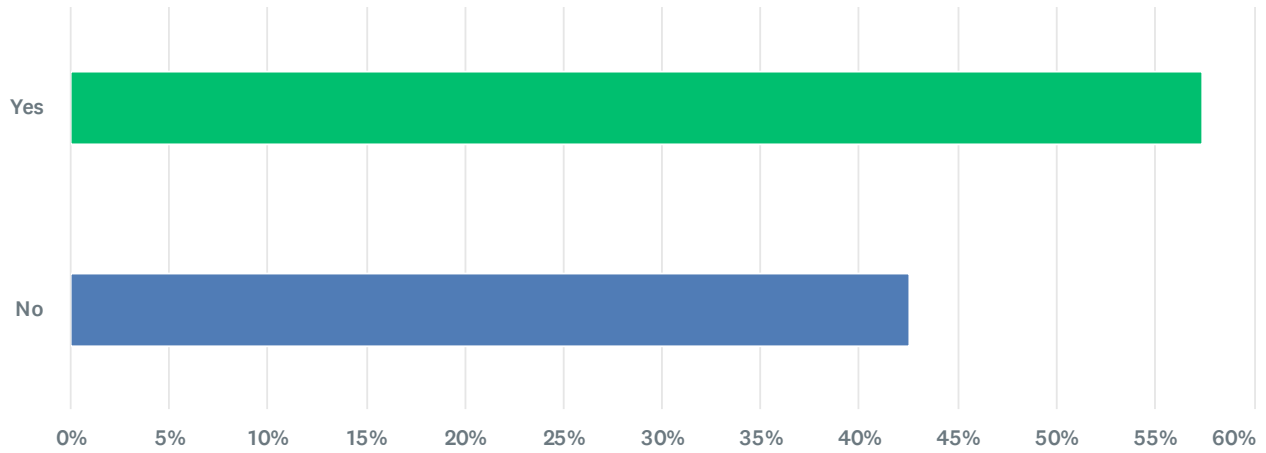

The Town is considering reducing the standard urban speed limit from 50km/h to 40km/h within Town boundaries. Playground, school, and construction zones will remain at 30km/h. Highways 14 & 41 speed limits are provincially legislated at 60km/h. Are you in favour of the reduction to 40km/h within Town limits?
